Terry Goddard to Participate in Tempe Shred-a-Thon

(Phoenix, Ariz. – July 12, 2007) Attorney General Terry Goddard and Assured Security Document Destruction (ASDD) will host a free Shred-a-Thon in Tempe on Tuesday, July 17, in an effort to prevent identity theft. This event will be held at the new ASDD facility located at 215 West Lodge Drive between 6 a.m. and 2 p.m.

“We are starting early Tuesday morning to provide an opportunity for residents to stop in before work,” Goddard said. “I hope people will take a few minutes out of their schedules to protect themselves against identity theft.”

Residents are encouraged to bring old bills, tax returns older than seven years, medical records and other documents containing personal identifying information to shred.

The Attorney General’s Fraud Fighter Van, Community Services staff and volunteers will be on hand with information about consumer protection and civil rights.
