Terry Goddard to Give Internet Safety Presentation in Fountain Hills

(Phoenix, Ariz. – Nov. 13, 2007) Attorney General Terry Goddard will discuss Internet safety with 200 eighth graders at Fountain Hills Middle School on Friday, November 14. Goddard will be joined by Principal Tom Brennan for the presentation beginning at 11:45 a.m.

Goddard will talk with students and teachers about precautions children should take when visiting chat rooms, gaming and social networking Web sites. The presentation will include interactive video presentations on Internet safety developed by NetSmartz and the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children.
