Terry Goddard to Host Crime Prevention Forum in Tucson

(Phoenix, Ariz. – October 15, 2008) Attorney General Terry Goddard invites Tucson residents to a Crime and Fraud Prevention Forum on Thursday, October 16, beginning at 7 p.m. The forum is being held to increase awareness of local crime trends, discuss successful prevention strategies and give citizens an opportunity to voice questions and concerns.

Goddard will be joined by a panel of local officials, including County Attorney Barbara LaWall, County Sheriff Clarence Dupnik, Tucson City Councilman Rodney Glassman and Tucson Police Captain Carla Johnson. The panelists will discuss a variety of community concerns, including abuse of methamphetamine and other drugs, identity theft, consumer scams, elder abuse, foreclosure and Internet safety.
