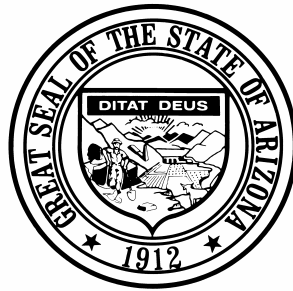

**Prescription Drug Prices
November 2003 Price Survey**

Antitrust Unit

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Executive Summary

Over the ten-year period, 1992-2002, prescription drug prices increased by an alarming 102 percent nationally. On an annual basis, prices have been climbing at over two times the rate of general price inflation in the economy. This rapid escalation of prices has increased consumers' concern about the long-term affordability of prescription drugs and has presented special hardships for individuals on fixed incomes and other at-risk populations.

In June 2001, the Arizona Attorney General's Office began conducting periodic surveys of prescription drug prices in Arizona. The purposes of the surveys have been to describe how prices have changed over time and vary across communities in the state.

This report details the prescription drug survey conducted in November 2003. In addition to documenting the retail cash-price of prescription drugs, the survey was expanded to collect information about pharmacy services and provide consumers with suggestions on how to save money when buying prescription drugs. In compiling this information, 833 pharmacies serving the general public were surveyed, with about 38 percent or 317 pharmacies providing responses. The survey also collected data on cash-prices of 20 popularly prescribed prescription drugs, approximately matching the drugs examined in previous surveys.

Results of the survey show that the price of drugs varies among pharmacies and across pharmacy types. Price differences between the high and low price for many drugs exceed 100 percent depending upon the specific pharmacy. The lowest prices for prescription drugs continue to be found through Internet pharmacies, while mass merchandise chains provide the lowest prices of "brick-and-mortar" pharmacies in Arizona. Additionally, the price of prescription drugs continues to rise in Arizona. Over the 14 month period between September 2002 and November 2003, the average price for same drugs increased between 4.79 percent and 77.65 percent, depending on the drug. The lowest price increase was for Viagra (4.79 percent), while the highest was for Zocor (77.65 percent).

Pharmacies in Arizona offer a variety of services, including: participation in discount programs; provision of home delivery services; compounding services; price matching of competitors' prices; 24-hour service; specialty services, such as asthma education; and diabetes consultation and other disease state management programs. While not all pharmacies offer all of these services, the availability of these service programs provides consumers with additional value when purchasing prescription drugs at those that do.

Although prices for prescription drugs continue to increase, consumers can minimize expenses through careful shopping. In addition to shopping for the lowest price, consumers should also be aware of safety issues, such as drug interactions, if purchasing prescription drugs from multiple sources. One way to minimize health risks when shopping for drugs is to disclose all the drugs being taken to each pharmacist.

Also, when shopping for drugs via the Internet, consumers should choose Internet pharmacies that carry the Verified Internet Pharmacy Practices (VIPPS) certification awarded by the National Association of Pharmacy Boards (NAPB). The VIPPS designation indicates the Internet site is properly licensed and its practices have been reviewed and found to comply with NAPB standards.

Numerous discount programs are offered or sponsored by pharmacies, government entities and purchasing clubs and membership affiliations. These programs can often save consumers money, but should be carefully evaluated to determine whether enrollment costs (if any) are worthwhile in light of projected savings. One discount program available to Arizona seniors is the Arizona Prescription Drug Discount program, which can save between 15 and 55 percent off the retail cash-price of drugs. Recent changes to the program have eliminated all enrollment costs and expanded its coverage to include additional manufacturer discounts for low-income seniors.

Other ways consumers can save money is to consult with their doctors and pharmacists on items such as generic drug availability, prescribing for more than a one month supply for chronic illnesses, and moving to the less expensive drug to achieve the same therapeutic results.

Section 1: Introduction

Rising Drug Prices

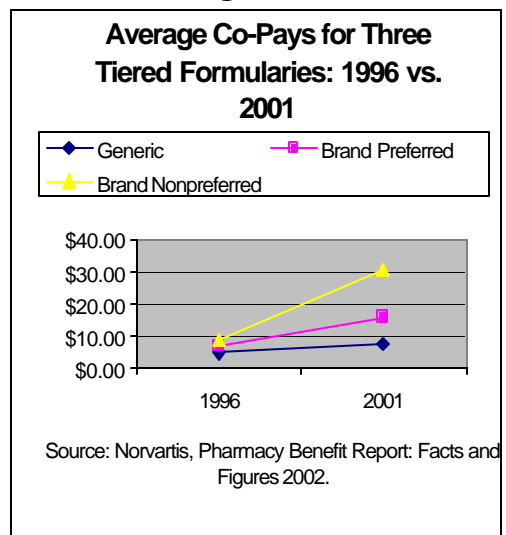
A major issue confronting many Americans is the rising cost of prescription drugs. Over the 10 year period, ending 2002, prescription drug prices increased 102.3 percent nationally, an annual average of 7.3 percent (Kaiser Foundation, May 2003). With prices of prescription drugs rising at more than twice the rate of inflation, the situation has heightened consumers' awareness of drug prices and present special hardships for the elderly, uninsured and individuals dependent upon social security benefits and other forms of fixed income.

The rising cost of prescription drugs is also a leading factor in the rapid rise in total health care costs, as drug costs have increased at double the rate of other health care costs (Kaiser Foundation, May 2003). According to the Kaiser Foundation, the national average retail price of prescription drugs in 2002 was \$54.58, while the average prescription drug price in Arizona was \$53.63 (Kaiser Foundation, 2003). In 2002, prescription drug costs comprised 11 percent of total health care expenditures and are projected to rise to 17 percent by 2012 (Kaiser Foundation, May 2003).

Recent studies report that the fastest growth in health care expenditures is among baby boomers whose rapid rise in income has led to a greater demand for health care, including prescription drugs (Wysocki, 2003). According to a report in *The Wall Street Journal*, "per capita spending [for health care] among Americans aged 30 to 50 rose more than 75 percent between 1987 and 2000 . . . a much faster growth rate than the elderly over the same period" (Wysocki, 2003).

While escalation of prescription drug costs certainly affects those individuals who lack insurance benefits and must pay the retail price for prescription drugs, individuals on health insurance plans are also paying more for their pharmaceutical benefits co-pays. Figure 1 shows the increase in drug benefits co-pays for three tiered plans. The data supporting Figure 1 reveals the escalation in insurance co-pays for three-tiered plans between 1996 and 2001. The average co-pay for generic drugs increased by 53 percent, while the average increase for preferred brand-name drug co-pays increased 130 percent and non-preferred drug co-pays increased 249 percent.

The reasons for the rapid rise in prescription drug costs vary and include the introduction of new, innovative drugs and increased prices by drug manufacturers to recover escalating costs of research and development.

Furthermore, with advances in medical treatments, the overall population is aging and living longer, thereby increasing demand for prescription drugs and putting upward pressure on drug prices. Additionally, newer, higher-priced drugs are being prescribed more often (Families USA, July 2003).

In response to increasing prescription drug prices, many individuals are seeking ways to lower their expenditures on prescription drugs. For example, some Arizonoans purchase prescription drugs from Mexico, Canada or other foreign countries, where prices are often lower than prices from licensed, Arizona pharmacies. However, the safety of such foreign imports has been questioned since neither the U.S. Food and Drug Administration nor the State of Arizona inspect drug imports for safety, reliability or efficacy.

Other ways consumers can save money include: purchasing drugs from Internet or mail order pharmacies; lowering the per pill cost by purchasing drugs in higher quantities, rather than one-month quantities; taking advantage of pharmacy, drug manufacturer and other discount programs; and working with one's doctor to prescribe lowest-cost drugs. Methods for saving money on prescription drugs and access to other, useful consumer information sources are described more fully in Section 4.

The Attorney General's November 2003 Prescription Drug Survey

As an update to three previous surveys conducted by the Attorney General's Office (June 2001, February 2002, September 2002), the Antitrust Unit conducted a fourth prescription drug price survey during November 2003. The 2003 survey builds upon the foundation of the previous surveys in capturing pricing data, but also incorporates new information about pharmacy services and pricing discount plans. Furthermore, the focus of the 2003 survey is to provide useful information to consumers on how and where to safely shop for prescription drugs. In addition to this report, the Attorney General's Office has produced a brochure, "The Arizona Attorney General's Guide for Purchasing Prescription Drugs," and an interactive pharmacy and drug pricing locator. The brochure is available in printed form by contacting the Attorney General's Office, and the pharmacy/pricing locator is available by visiting the Attorney General's Web site at www.azag.gov.

The remainder of this report is divided into the following sections: Section 2 describes the methods used to obtain pricing data from Arizona pharmacies; Section 3 presents the results of the November 2003 prescription drug pricing survey; and Section 4 provides information about how consumers might be able to save money when purchasing prescription drugs.

The Attorney General appreciates the cooperation of the pharmacies participating in the survey and thanks those who returned completed survey data forms. Recognition also

goes to the Executive Director of the Arizona Board of Pharmacy for assistance in reviewing the survey form and providing contact information for the approximately 1,100 licensed pharmacies in the state. The Arizona Pharmacy Association (APA) and its members furnished information concerning safety issues related to foreign drug imports and purchasing prescription drugs from multiple pharmacies. The APA also described pharmacy cost issues, helpful in explaining why prices at certain licensed pharmacies are higher than others.

Section 2: Methodology

The Arizona pricing data gathered for this report were obtained directly from licensed pharmacies throughout the state. Survey forms containing the list of 20 sample drugs, as well as questions about pharmacy services, were provided to 833 licensed pharmacies providing prescription drug services to the general public. A copy of the survey form (and attached cover letter) is provided as Appendix A. For chain drugstores, pharmacies in major grocery stores and mass merchandising pharmacies, a survey form for each of the chains' stores was mailed to the designated Arizona representative for each chain. For independent pharmacies and community health clinic pharmacies, a survey form was faxed to each pharmacy. A full listing of pharmacies contacted for pricing data is provided in Appendix B. The survey forms were distributed in late October 2003 with request for completion and return to the Attorney General's Office by November 15, 2003.

Selecting the Pharmacies

Attorney General prescription drug surveys conducted in 2001 and 2002 collected pricing data from a relatively small sample of pharmacies. In the June 2001 survey, for example, prices were obtained from only 50 pharmacies, while 153 pharmacies were contacted for the September 2002 survey, with 107 pharmacies providing responses.

For the November 2003 survey, it was decided to contact all licensed pharmacies in the state providing prescription drug services to the public. The survey size was expanded because: 1) the availability of the full list of licensed pharmacies in electronic format simplified the process of contacting the pharmacies; and 2) anticipation of gathering data from more pharmacies could increase the reliability of analysis and inferences made from the data.

The full list of licensed pharmacies, containing approximately 1,100 licensed pharmacy locations, was obtained from the Arizona Board of Pharmacy. Each pharmacy on the list was reviewed to determine whether the pharmacy was likely to fill prescriptions for the general public. Based on this analysis, certain pharmacies were eliminated from further consideration in the survey. Generally, hospital pharmacies, infusion pharmacies and veterinary pharmacies were eliminated (we did not eliminate community clinic pharmacies like Morenci Healthcare Center, since data for those clinics were collected in the prior surveys). The remaining 833 pharmacies (see Appendix B) represented the universe of Arizona pharmacies for this survey.

Selecting the list of Drugs

In selecting the list of 20 drugs for inclusion in the survey, the beginning point was the list of drugs for the September 2002 survey. This list, which contained the names of 20 prescription drugs, was then reviewed by several pharmacists. Based on the review, two changes were made. The prescription drugs, Pempro and Xanax, were removed from the list, and Atenolol and Levoxyl were added. Additionally, the recommendation

to obtain generic prices on four drugs was incorporated into the survey. These drugs included: Augmentin, BuSpar, Cardizem CD and Prozac.¹

Pharmacies Responding to the Survey

Pharmacies were requested to respond with pricing and services data by November 15, 2003. Of the 833 pharmacies contacted, 317 pharmacies or 38.1 percent of the total provided pricing and services data. Table 1 shows the response rate by pharmacy group.

As Table 1 indicates, the vast majority of pharmacies, 87.8 percent, in Arizona are chain pharmacies, associated with drugstores, grocery stores and mass merchandisers. While the overall response rate for the chains was 38.2 percent (slightly higher than the response rate of smaller, independent pharmacies), only about one-half of the chain parent stores provided data for their pharmacies.

Those chain pharmacies (including mass merchandise retailers, drugstores and grocery/supermarkets) **not** providing data are shown in Table 2.²

¹ These four drugs were subsequently eliminated from additional analysis due to inconsistent reporting of prices. Some pharmacies reported generic prices for these drugs, while other pharmacies reported the prices for the brand name drug.

² Although Cigna is a Health Maintenance Organization, it does fill prescriptions for its members, which represent a sizable portion of the state's population. Therefore, Cigna was contacted for participation in the survey.

Data Limitations and Interpretation

While every attempt was made to obtain current, reliable pricing data for 20 popularly prescribed drugs (Table 3), the accuracy of the survey is largely dependent upon the accuracy of self-reported drug prices by individual pharmacies and pharmacists. In reviewing the data responses, some prices looked suspiciously high or low. In these cases, follow-up telephone calls were made to determine accuracy, and erroneous data were corrected, where possible.

For four of the drugs on the original list of 20 drugs, we specifically requested pricing data for the drugs' generic equivalents. However, inspection of the data indicated a range of prices that included both the brand name drug price and the generic equivalent. Given time and resource constraints, the effort to correct the data for these four drugs was judged too great. Therefore, it was decided to drop these drugs from further analysis in this report. The drugs dropped from further analysis are Augmentin, Buspar, Cardizem CD and Prozac.

It should also be noted that the survey reflects only a snapshot of prescription drug prices taken in mid-November 2003. In reality, prescription drug prices can change frequently. Factors affecting price changes include: changes in manufacturing costs; introduction of generic drug equivalents; timing of patent expiration; bulk purchasing power of particular pharmacies; and changes in pharmacy overhead costs and pricing policies.

Finally, the prices contained in this report are intended only as a guide. Because prices can change frequently, consumers should check prices with pharmacies in advance of purchasing.

Section 3: Survey Results

Prices Vary by Type of Pharmacy Store

A major finding is that prices of prescription drugs vary by type of pharmacy. Generally, prices are cheapest when purchased from Internet pharmacies and mass merchandise retailers such as Costco. Prices tend to be highest for smaller independent pharmacies and some chain drugstores and reflect, in part, the underlying differences in costs.

Additionally, prescription drugs purchased from Community Clinics can be less expensive than most retail pharmacies, but may be obtained only by qualified patients of the Community Clinics.⁴

Tables 4 through 8 show the November 2003 average price of 16 drugs by type of pharmacy.⁵ Table 4 displays summary data for the entire state for all brick and mortar pharmacies (Internet pharmacies were excluded from tabulations contained in Table 4). Tables 5 through 8 show prices for Chain Pharmacies, Independent Pharmacies, Community Health Clinics and Internet Pharmacies, respectively. In addition to average price for each drug, Tables 4 through 8 also contain statistics for price range (high price, low price) and standard deviation.

⁴ The Community Clinics are provided funding and resources through the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, under programs directed by the Health Resources and Services Administration and implemented through the Bureau of Primary Health Care (BHPC). One goal of the agency is to provide primary health care to medically underserved people and to serve women and children through state programs (Health Resources and Services Administration, 2003). The Community Clinics serve as a nationally sponsored health care “safety net” to poor and near poor Americans. A list of Community Clinics in Arizona is provided in Appendix D.

⁵ Although the data were collected for each individual pharmacy, this report displays the data only by group of pharmacy. Consumers wishing specific prices for a particular pharmacy should call the pharmacy directly to inquire about prices.

As expected, the Community Health Clinics, which are funded with taxpayer dollars, produce the lowest prices for all but one of the 16 prescription drugs.⁷ However, these prices are only available to qualifying patients of the clinics and not available to the general public.

In examining prices for all Arizona brick-and-mortar pharmacies (Table 4), the combined average price of all 16 drugs is \$86.66. The range of prices differs for each drug, with some drugs exhibiting greater price spread between low-priced and high-priced stores⁸. For example, the spread between high and low prices for Allegra (60, 60mg tabs) is between \$57.20 and \$104.54, a difference of 82.76 percent. The high-priced store in this case is an independent pharmacy, while the low-priced pharmacy is a community health clinic.

Comparing Prices Between Chains and Independents (Tables 5 and 6)

In comparing chain pharmacies and independents, the combined average price for 16 drugs is only slightly higher for independent pharmacies than for chain pharmacies. For the 16 drugs, the average price for all chain pharmacies is \$86.73, while the average price across independents is \$87.53 – a difference of about one percent. However, in examining the lowest price for specific drugs, the independent pharmacies produced the lowest price for 11 of the 16 drugs. The independent pharmacies were also responsible for producing the highest prices for 14 of the 16 drugs when compared to the high-end prices for chain pharmacies. On average, independent pharmacies were lower in price than chain pharmacies for four drugs: Lipitor, Nexium, Prevacid, and Singulair.

Another measure of price variation among pharmacies is the standard deviation. In comparing prices between independents and chain pharmacies, the amount of variance as measured by the standard deviation is relatively small across all drugs, while the price variance for independents is greater. The greater variation in prices for the independent group is a reflection of greater diversity of operations, drug procurement costs and overhead costs among independent pharmacies. For consumers, a relatively high standard deviation means that prices can differ significantly from store to store, so it might pay to shop around.

For consumers, what these statistics show is that prices differ among individual pharmacies and pharmacy types – sometimes dramatically. Depending on prescription drug needs, consumers can save money by shopping around. For example, the independent pharmacy average price for Lipitor⁹ (\$76.72) is approximately 3.5 percent

less than the average price among chain pharmacies (\$79.37) and exhibits less variation from independent to independent. As another example, the chain pharmacy average price for Atenolol¹⁰ (\$13.88) is 32 percent lower than the independents' average price (\$20.56).

Prices can also vary substantially among similar stores. For example, the price of Allegra among the independent pharmacies ranges from a low of \$69.69 (60, 60mg tabs) to a high of \$104.54 – a price spread of 50 percent. Similar price differences exist among chain pharmacies. The high chain store price for Lipitor (30, 10mg tabs) is \$103.99, while the low priced chain store has Lipitor priced at \$79.37, a difference of 31 percent. Among chain pharmacies, the lowest priced stores are typically mass merchandise retailers, which provide pharmacy services alongside high volume, diversified retail merchandise. Those higher priced chain pharmacies typically operate either together with a grocery store/supermarket or as a combination pharmacy/small retail store.¹¹

Comparing Internet Prices

Table 8 provides pricing data acquired for Internet pharmacies. The average Internet price for the 16 drugs is \$75.57, approximately 14.8 percent lower than for Arizona brick-and-mortar pharmacies. However, the Internet price is not always the lowest price for a particular drug. Even when the community clinics are excluded, brick-and-mortar pharmacies are lower than Internet pharmacies for seven of the sixteen drugs. However, the high-priced Internet pharmacies tend not to be as high as the highest priced chain or independent brick-and-mortar stores.

Although drug prices tend to be lower, on average, for Internet pharmacies, consumers should note that most Internet pharmacies charge a shipping fee. This fee can range from a dollar or two to several dollars, depending upon customer delivery requirements, and must be added to the drug cost to arrive at a total cost.

Prices Vary by Geographical Location

Tables 9 through 12 show prices for the 16 drugs by geographic area. In general, while some variation exists among geographic areas in the state, the differences are relatively small. For example, the average price for 16 drugs differs by only four cents between Phoenix metro pharmacies and Tucson metro pharmacies. The spread between the highest average price for 16 drugs between the high price community and low price community is \$2.24, or about 2.5 percent.¹² Furthermore, for some drugs, prices are

actually lower in smaller communities than in the Phoenix or Tucson metro areas, although these differences are generally minor.

The similarity in pricing among geographic areas of the state is due in part to the dominance of chain pharmacies that operate stores in many communities. While some chain pharmacies price prescription drugs based on area, or zone formulas, the price differentials among Arizona communities are small. Other chain pharmacies maintain uniform pricing across all communities. Another factor driving geographic pricing decisions of pharmacies is increased shopping via the Internet. Increased access to the Internet has lessened the importance and usefulness of zone pricing among brick-and-mortar pharmacies because the Internet provides consumers with borderless shopping choices.

Prices Have Increased Since the 2001 and 2002 Surveys (Figure 2 and Table 13)

Figure 2 presents graphs for 12 drugs for which price comparisons can be made with prior Attorney General price surveys. The data reflect the average price for each drug for all brick-and-mortar pharmacies in Arizona.¹³ For all 12 drugs, price changes are calculated between the September 2002 and November 2003 surveys, a period of 14 months. However, price data from earlier surveys is not consistently available for several of the drugs. Nevertheless, price comparisons on six drugs¹⁴ can be made for the period June 2001 to November 2003, a period of 29 months.

As the graphs in Figure 2 show, prices for each of the 12 drugs increased between the 2002 and 2003 surveys. However, the rates of price increase vary for each drug over the 14-month period. The percentage change over the 14-month period for each drug is shown in Table 13. The drug with the greatest price increase during this period is Zocor, increasing by 77.65 percent. The drugs Allegra and Viagra had the smallest price increases, with Allegra increasing by 4.65 percent and Viagra by 4.79 percent. Four drugs, Lipitor, Nexium, Ortho Tri-Cyclen and Prevacid, experienced price increases between 10 and 20 percent.

Figure 2: Price Changes 2001 – 2003 for 12 Drugs

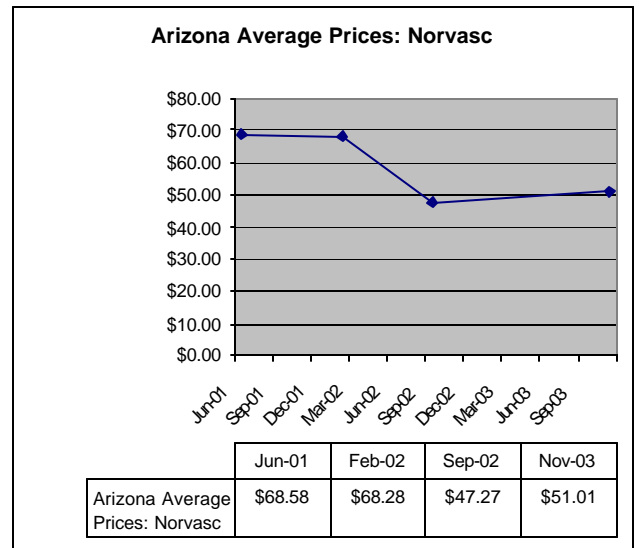
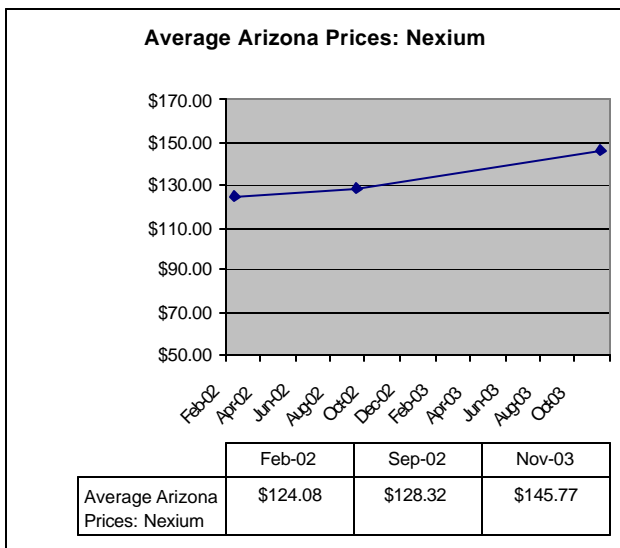
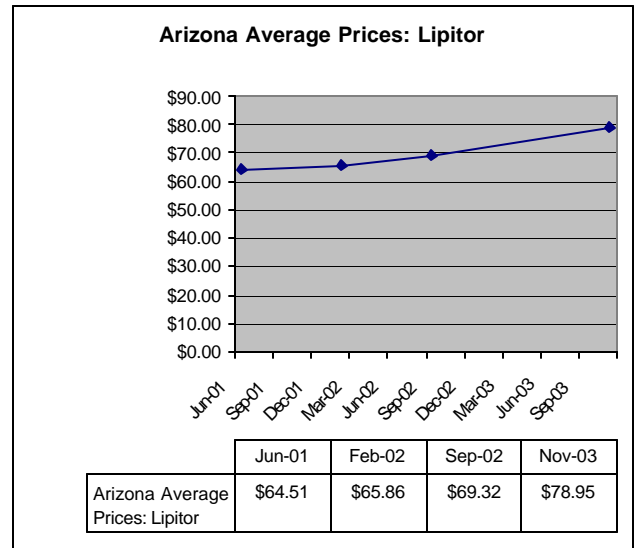
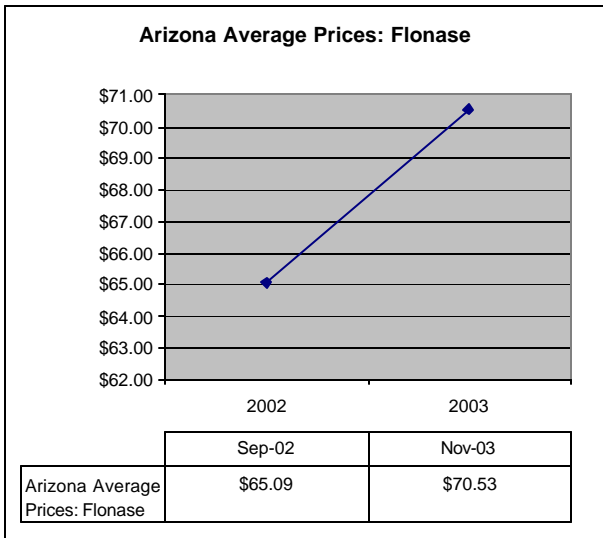
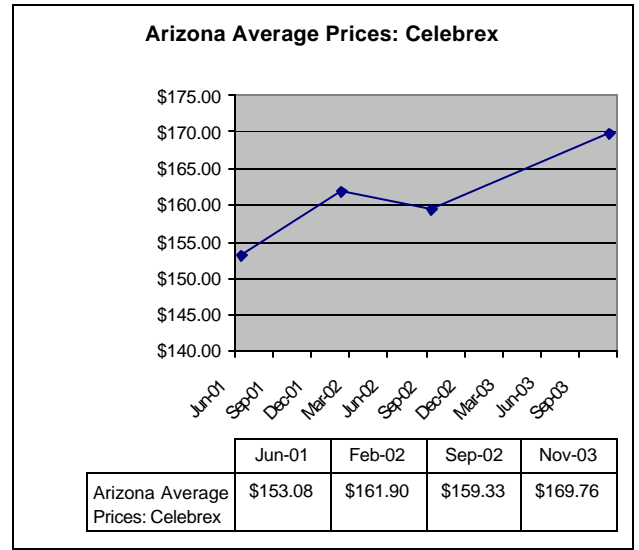
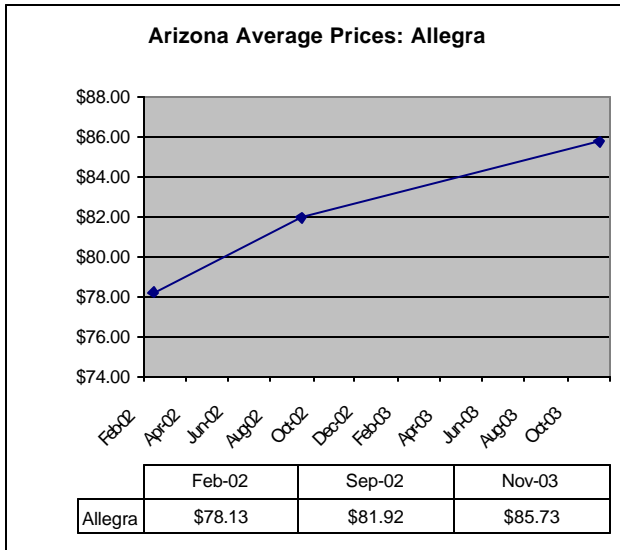


Figure 2 (continued)

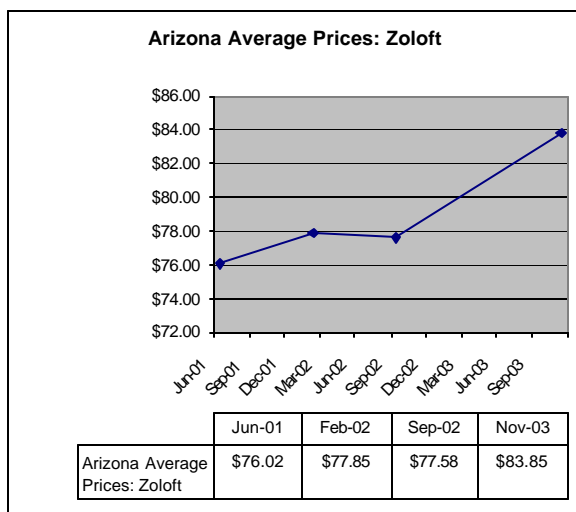
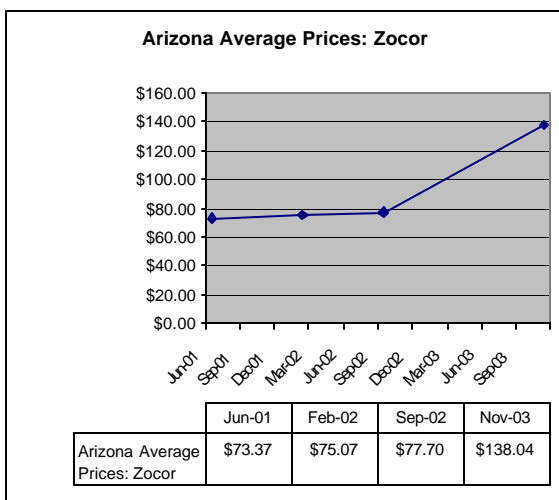
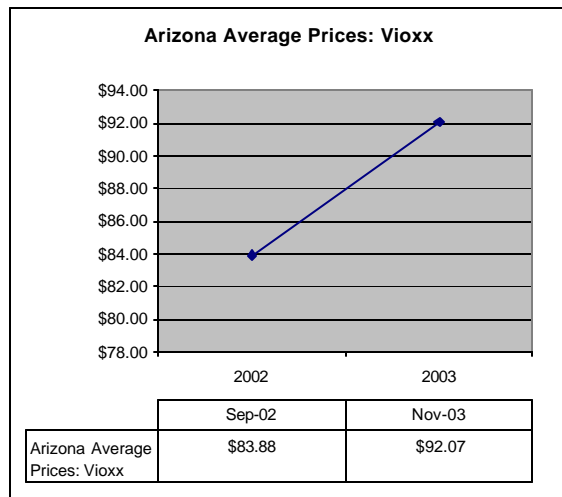
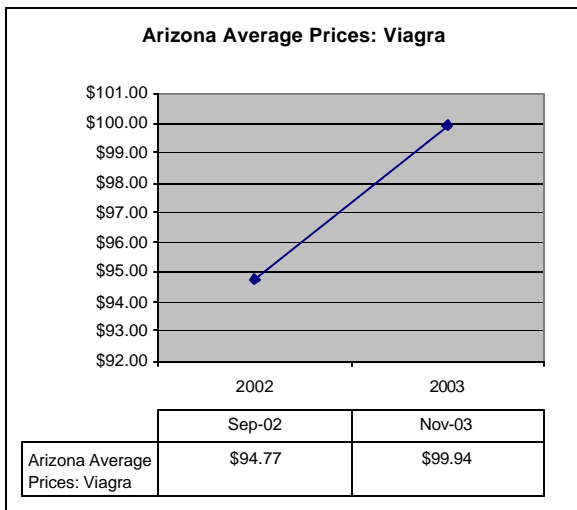
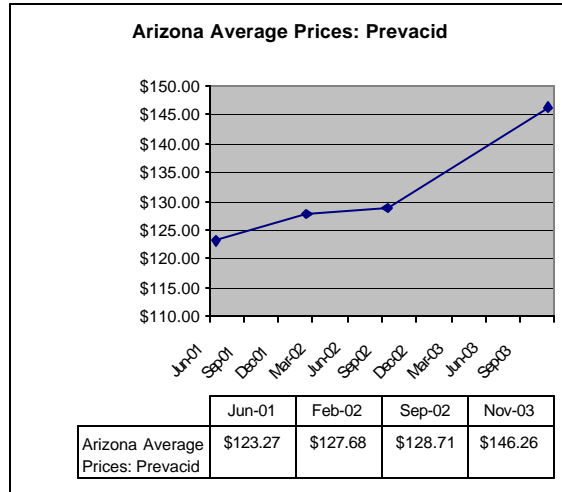
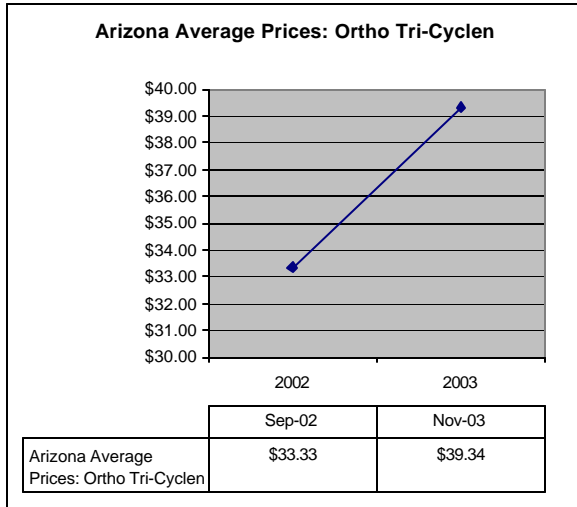

Services

In addition to filling prescriptions, pharmacies and pharmacists offer a variety of services to their customers. This survey identified and documented the services offered by pharmacies.

Table 14 lists the pharmacy services for which information was collected. Additionally, Table 14 provides a tabulation of the number of responding pharmacies that provide each service. As shown in Table 14, a large proportion of pharmacies provides at least one type of special service. Services provided include:

- Approximately 91.5 percent of the pharmacies participate in some form of consumer discount program, while 76 percent offer home delivery services.¹⁵
- Compounding services are customized preparations of prescription drugs, which are sometimes necessary to avoid allergic reactions to a drug's non-active ingredients, or to transform the drug into a more easily ingested form for certain patients. Compounding services are offered by about 49 percent of the pharmacies responding to the survey.
- Another service offered by many Arizona pharmacies is price matching. Of the pharmacies responding to the survey, 88.3 percent indicated that they would match the price of a competitor.

- Over 78 percent of pharmacies in Arizona offer 24-hour service. And, 86.8 percent offer one or more specialty, consultative services on the treatment of certain illnesses and diseases. Examples of consultative services include: diabetes management; asthma; hormone counseling; pulmonary care; fertility specialist; pediatric asthma education; anti-coagulant management; and disease state management.

Discount Plans

The previous section presented retail, full-cash price information for 16 selected drugs for the period November 2003. Only a small percentage of consumers actually pay the full cash price for prescription drugs. The majority of consumers are covered by medical insurance plans with prescription drug benefits, under which only a portion of the insurance plans' cost for the drug is paid as an out-of-pocket payment. Additionally, many consumers not covered by medical insurance may be eligible for participation in drug discount programs, which offer their members discounts off the cash-retail price. Discount plans are offered and sponsored by numerous entities, including pharmacies, government agencies, purchasing clubs and other member affiliations.

Most discount programs require payment of an up-front membership fee with percentage discounts on future prescription drug purchases. Consumers considering enrolling in a discount program should carefully review the program's terms and conditions. Consumers should also carefully calculate and evaluate whether any membership costs can be recovered through the plan's estimated savings, based upon projected prescription drug purchases.

State of Arizona's Discount Program

In June 2003, Governor Janet Napolitano created the Arizona Prescription Drug Discount Card program by Executive Order. The plan as initially introduced offered price discounts ranging from 15 to 55 percent to Medicaid-eligible seniors and disabled Arizonans who pay the cash price for prescription drugs for an annual fee of \$9.95 (Arizona Office of the Governor, 2003).

On January 7, 2004, Governor Napolitano announced changes to the discount program, which eliminated the annual fee and introduced the CopperRx card to be mailed to all Medicare-eligible individuals in Arizona. The revised program continues to provide discounts ranging from 15 to 55 percent off retail cash-price, for all brand and generic drugs. When using the discount card, consumers must also pay a dispensing fee of three dollars to the pharmacy.¹⁶ The program also incorporates information on additional discounts available from drug manufacturers for low-income individuals. Additionally, the program covers the gaps in the current Medicaid programs, which require an initial deductible of \$250 and contain no coverage for drug expenses between \$2,250 and \$5,100 (Arizona Office of the Governor, 2004).

Section 4: Tips for Lowering Your Costs for Prescription Drugs

This section provides useful information about how to safely shop for prescription drugs to save money. The information presented contains suggestions on how and where to shop, as well as how to work with your physician and pharmacist to minimize prescription drug costs, while recognizing safety in obtaining and taking prescription drugs is paramount.

As the data presented in Section 3 of this report show, prices for prescription drugs can vary dramatically from pharmacy to pharmacy. The price variances generally reflect differences in the underlying costs of pharmacy operations and the ability of pharmacies to obtain the best prices from drug manufacturers and wholesalers. For example, mass merchandise stores often have lower prices than chain drugstores or independent pharmacies, since the overhead costs supporting pharmacy operations can be spread over sales of other merchandise. Chain drugstores, including combination grocery/pharmacies, which offer a variety of specialty pharmacy services, often have an advantage over smaller independent drugstores because they can purchase drugs from wholesalers and drug manufacturers in large quantities at lower costs.

Internet and mail order pharmacies often have the lowest prices since their costs are lower. Consumers who are comfortable with Internet and mail order prescription drug purchases often save the most, although receipt of the drugs may be delayed several days and shipping costs are often added to the cost of the prescription.

Tips to Save Money on Prescription Drugs

Ask Your Doctor

Although the doctor–patient relationship is well defined for medical purposes, many patients do not realize that consultation with their doctor about lowering the costs of prescription drugs is an important and accepted part of receiving medical care. It is also the first step in saving money on prescription drugs for insured and uninsured patients alike. Questions that consumers/patients should ask their doctor include:

- If a brand drug is prescribed, ask if there is a generic available that your doctor could prescribe;
- If you have prescription drug insurance benefits, ask your doctor if the drug he/she prescribes has the lowest co-pay for your insurance formulary. If not, ask if another drug with a lower co-pay can be prescribed to achieve the same result;
- If you have a prescription drug you take regularly, ask your doctor if he/she can prescribe a three or six month supply so you can receive a quantity discount when you purchase;
- Ask your doctor if he/she can prescribe a higher dosage for your medication, so you can split the pill in half;
- Ask your doctor if he/she is aware of low cost pharmacies or where to shop for the lowest prices in filling a prescription;

- Ask your doctor and/or pharmacist whether he/she is aware of discount programs that might save you money on your prescription;
- Ask your doctor if he/she can provide you any free samples of your prescription.

Shop Around and Ask About Discounts

The Attorney General's survey of prescription drugs reveals that prices vary from pharmacy to pharmacy. Consumers can save substantial sums if they are willing to shop around for their prescription drugs. However, consumers who take multiple prescription drugs should always tell their pharmacist about all the drugs they are taking since certain drugs can cause adverse reactions when taken in combination with other drugs. If a potential adverse drug interaction is possible, the pharmacist can alert the patient and doctor and seek an alternative prescription from the doctor, if necessary.

Some pharmacies will price match their competitors. If you have a regular pharmacy, ask if it matches the prices of competitors. If it does, call several other pharmacies in your neighborhood on the price for your prescription and take the lowest price to your regular pharmacy for a price match. This might require several minutes on the telephone calling other pharmacies, but the potential cost savings could be significant. For convenience, the names, addresses and telephone numbers for all pharmacies serving the general public in Arizona is provided in Appendix B. Additionally, a list of pharmacies by postal zip code is available over the Internet at the Attorney General's Web site at www.ag.state.az.us.

Additionally, a variety of discount programs are available to qualifying consumers. For example, many chain drugstores offer in-house discount programs for drug purchases. Typically, consumers must pay an initial fee that can range from a few dollars to \$50, or more per year to receive the discount, typically 10 to 15 percent. Since the initial fee can be quite high, consumers should carefully examine the discount plan and calculate potential cost savings. If you are uncertain about any pharmacy discount program, ask the pharmacist whether you would save money on the plan.

Another discount plan is the Prescription Drug Discount Program for Arizona Seniors. This plan, described in the previous section, is sponsored by the State of Arizona and provides price discounts ranging from 15 to 55 percent for participating seniors. Information about this plan, including the participating pharmacies, is available over the Internet at www.rxamerica.com/az_discount_home.htm or by calling 1-888-227-8315.

Many drug manufacturers offer special discount programs for low-income individuals. The specific programs vary by manufacturer and can be reviewed by contacting the drug manufacturer directly or by asking your pharmacist about such programs. Additionally, the drug manufacturers' trade association, Phrma, provides an Internet Web site with information about patient assistance programs. Consumers visiting the Phrma Web site at www.helpingpatients.com can access information about a drug company's assistance programs as well as addresses and telephone numbers for

additional information. Appendix C provides a list of the top drug manufacturers with corporate contact information.

Similarly, some drug manufacturers provide rebates directly for purchasing their drugs. The rebates are usually obtained through coupons made available through pharmacies. Consumers should ask their pharmacist whether rebates or other discounts might be available from drug manufacturers when filling their prescriptions.

Internet Shopping

Each year, more and more consumers shop for products over the Internet. Internet shopping has expanded to include prescription drugs, which are available from Internet pharmacies. Because Internet pharmacies have fewer costs than brick-and-mortar pharmacies, the prices of drugs purchased over the Internet are usually lower and Internet shoppers can save money.

Although Internet pharmacies usually provide information about drugs as well as instructions for taking the drugs, contact with a pharmacist is not automatic, nor is it guaranteed. Purchasing prescription drugs over the Internet also imposes transaction costs, which are not typically incurred when purchasing from brick-and-mortar pharmacies. These costs include delay in receiving the drugs through the mail, shipping costs and possible inability to engage a pharmacist to answer questions in real time.

Consumers choosing to shop for prescription drugs over the Internet should look for Internet pharmacies that are sanctioned by the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy (NABP). The NABP sponsors the Verified Internet Pharmacy Practice Sites (VIPPS) program, which certifies Internet pharmacies meeting NABP's criteria. NABP examines whether the Internet pharmacy is appropriately licensed, is legitimately operating via the Internet, and has passed NABP's review and on-site inspection. While NABP does not regulate VIPPS-qualified pharmacies, a VIPPS designation indicates that the Internet site is operating in a legitimate fashion and has been licensed by the appropriate licensing authority and is practicing competent Internet pharmacy practices (National Association of Boards of Pharmacy, 2003). Additional information about the VIPPS program is available by accessing the NABP Web site at www.nabp.net.

As another precaution, consumers should avoid both solicited and unsolicited web sites advertising drugs without a doctor's prescription. All pharmacies, including Internet pharmacies, can only provide drugs through a valid doctor's prescription.

The United States Food and Drug Administration provides additional, consumer information about buying drugs on-line. This information can be accessed via the Internet at www.fda.gov/fdac/features/2000/100.

Purchasing Prescription Drugs from Foreign Countries

In an effort to relieve the financial burden on Arizonans associated with the high price of prescription medications, on May 4, 2004, Attorney General Goddard joined the

Attorneys General from eighteen other states in requesting that U.S. Health and Human Services Secretary Tommy Thompson immediately exercise his authority to allow for the safe importation of FDA approved prescription drugs from licensed Canadian pharmacies. Because of government controls, Canadian pharmacies can sell FDA-approved prescription drugs at significantly lower prices than their counterparts in the U.S. Attorney General Goddard and the Attorneys General who signed the letter strongly believe that the States, working with the FDA and Health Canada, can develop importation procedures to ensure a safe supply of low cost prescription drugs for American consumers and state governments.

With the rapid rise in prescription drug prices, consumers are increasingly looking to reduce costs by having prescriptions filled by pharmacies outside the United States, where drug prices are typically lower. Many Arizonans travel to Mexico to have prescriptions filled, while others purchase prescription drugs from Canadian pharmacies over the Internet. Arizona consumers are not alone in the quest for lower priced foreign drug imports. Recently, government officials in states like Massachusetts, Minnesota, Iowa and Illinois, and others have announced efforts to obtain lower priced Canadian drugs for their employees and citizens.

At the present time, U.S. laws prohibit the importation of prescription drugs from foreign countries, even with a valid doctor's prescription. These laws are designed to protect consumers from acquiring counterfeit or unsafe drugs, but also facilitate the ability of drug manufacturers to maintain higher domestic prices.

The issue of foreign drug imports is currently under considerable debate in state governments and the United States Congress. The Arizona Attorney General's Office is monitoring this issue and participating in the national debate to protect both the economic and safety concerns of Arizona citizens.
