ICAC Quick Facts

- Attorney General Mark Brnovich and Representative Paul Boyer have joined forces to catch the perpetrators exploiting children online; Boyer is sponsoring The Internet Crimes Against Children Enforcement Fund
- The Internet Crimes Against Children Enforcement Fund would give General Brnovich the authority to disperse \$4.5 Mil to ICAC (Internet Crimes Against Children) annually & provide \$500,000 for a victims' fund
- Rep. Boyer has proposed this legislation to hire 15 full-time investigators and three forensic examiners, more than doubling the existing ICAC staff
 - Of approximately 100 leads investigated annually by ICAC, all have led to prosecution
 - ICAC rescued 70 victims of child abuse and child pornography in 2014
- According to the US Marshal's Office, 50-70% of those who trade child pornography are also raping, molesting and torturing children
- According to ICAC, 70 percent of child pornography victims are prepubescent and 7 percent are infants
