This conduct occurred when Defendant VICTORIA O. ROMERO (001) knowingly aided the fraud scheme in which Carmen Tolle falsely represented that she could obtain legitimate resident alien identification cards for persons who paid her a fee and submitted to an application process that included having their fingerprints taken. Defendant VICTORIA O. ROMERO (001), knowing that Tolle was a convicted felon and that she could not obtain legitimate resident alien identification cards for anyone, sometimes played the role of the "official" who took the applicants' fingerprints, and she sometimes wore her Arizona Department of Corrections uniform while doing so.

COUNT 2 (CONSPIRACY)

Between approximately June 2004 and May 2005, Defendant VICTORIA O. ROMERO (001), with the intent to promote or aid the commission of an offense, namely, the fraud scheme charged in Count 1 of this Indictment, agreed with one or more persons both known and unknown to the State Grand Jury that at least one of those persons or another person would engage in conduct constituting that offense, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-1003, 13-2310, 13-2301, 13-305, 13-306, 13-701, 13-702, 13-702.01, and 13-801.

In furtherance of this conspiracy and to effect its objects, Defendant VICTORIA O. ROMERO (001) and other persons committed overt acts, including the following:

On June 22, 2004, Defendant VICTORIA O. ROMERO used her credit card, or knowingly allowed her credit card to be used, to make an internet purchase from Sirchie Fingerprint Laboratories, Inc. of:

a. 1 portable fingerprint stand mounted on a pedestal;

b. 1 fingerprint roller and ink; and,

c. 100 FBI fingerprint cards.

2. On July 21, 2004, Defendant VICTORIA O. ROMERO used her credit card, or knowingly allowed her credit card to be used, to make an internet purchase from Sirchie Fingerprint Laboratories, Inc. of 200 FBI fingerprint cards.

COUNT 3 (MONEY LAUNDERING)

Between approximately June 2004 and May 2005, Defendant VICTORIA O.
ROMERO (001) knowingly received racketeering proceeds knowing or having reason to
know that they were the proceeds of an offense, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-2317(B), 132301, 13-301, 13-302, 13-303, 13-304, 13-701, 13-702, 13-702.01, and 13-801.

This conduct occurred when Defendant VICTORIA O. ROMERO (001) received
 money from Carmen Tolle for fingerprinting persons at Tolle's residence, knowing that
 those payments were the proceeds of a fraud scheme that was based on false pretenses that
 Carmen Tolle, for a fee, could obtain legitimate resident alien identification cards for the
 persons whose fingerprints were being taken by Defendant VICTORIA O. ROMERO (001).
 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 21-425, the State Grand Jurors find that all above-described
 offenses were committed in Maricopa County.
