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**RE: Additional Questions About The March 1, 2019 Events At Perry High School**

Ms. Dooley:

Thank you for the information provided in your April 8, 2019 response to this Office's March 5, 2019 letter. Having reviewed your submission, as well as additional material obtained from other sources, this letter seeks some further, related information and clarification.

1. Please confirm in writing the identities of "Student A" and "Parent A" as described in your April 8 response.
2. Please clarify the timeline of events on March 1, 2019 related to Student A's suspension, in particular;
  - a. Regarding paragraph 6 of Principal Dan Serrano's statement and paragraphs 11 and 12 of Assistant Principal Heather Patterson's statement, whether the conversation between Mr. Serrano and Ms. Patterson occurred before or after Jennifer Farris departed the school's administration office and how much time elapsed between those events.
  - b. Regarding paragraphs 7 and 8 of Mr. Serrano's statement, whether the conversations between Mr. Serrano, Student A, and Parent A took place before or after Jennifer Farris departed the school's administration office and how much time elapsed between those events.
  - c. Regarding paragraph 7 of Mr. Serrano's statement and paragraph 11 of Ms. Patterson's statement, whether either or both Mr. Serrano and Ms. Patterson were informed or otherwise aware that Student A was or may have been told by a parent to not answer questions until the parent arrived.
  - d. Regarding paragraph 11 of Ms. Patterson's statement, whether Ms. Patterson knew or had reason to believe Student A was present at the school's

administration office because SRO Jesse Allen ordered or requested that Student A go there.

- e. Regarding paragraph 8 of Mr. Serrano's statement, whether this was the first time Mr. Serrano verbally communicated that Student A would be suspended.
  - f. Whether Mr. Serrano told Student A and Parent A that Student A would be suspended for 10 days.
3. Please clarify whether the conversation between Mr. Serrano, Student A, and Parent A on March 1, 2019 served as a "Conference" as indicated on the "District Infraction and Consequence Chart."
  4. Please clarify whether Student A initially was suspended for 10 days and how Student A's suspension ultimately became 3 days.
  5. If Student A initially was suspended for 10 days, please explain any process or reasons that contributed to reducing the suspension to 3 days.
  6. Please clarify whether Student A or Parent A requested having Student A's suspension removed from Student A's school record and whether the school responded to any such request.
  7. Please state whether Student A's record contains any additional or previous disciplinary action, and, if so, the nature, length, and resolution of those actions.
