One pending update, in the device level settings will be on by default if sWAA is enabled for the signed in account. This change completes the launch that referenced.

Also note that sWAA is on by default for all $\square$ as of July 2016, that's another driver of growth.
Some accounts are not eligible for sWAA, for example, sWAA can not be enabled for GAFE domains and is disabled for most Dasher domains.
