You know, for a Zwieback cookie which is like a person but just one device, or for a Gaia cookie which is like a person who can use multiple devices.

table in this slide that covers retention, format,

location and some of the contents.

For example, in my mind the session ids are linked to gaia, but if the user deletes anything from My Activity then the link is broken forever (and that gaia appears again as a new session). Right?
