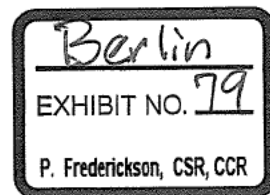

Description	<p>SUMMARY: The sWAA and DI UDC settings have both account-level consent and device-level upload settings; this launch focuses on the device-level. Today, the device level upload setting is a) off by default, and b) is not turned on when the account-level consent is turned on. This launch update the sWAA and DI device-level settings to behave similar to the Location History/Reporting setting: turning on the account-level setting will also turn on the device level setting.
