- ❖ To learn about your rights under the permanent injunction issued by the U.S. District Court of Arizona, and how to help the Arizona Attorney General's Office enforce the injunction to stop the pattern or practice of "severe and pervasive discrimination" in providing culinary water connections and other municipal services by Colorado City, Hilldale, and their associated utility providers.
- ❖ To hear from representatives of Mohave County and Washington County law enforcement agencies about how to help them ensure that everyone is treated equally regardless of religion.
- ❖ To ask questions of representatives of the Arizona Attorney General's Office, the Mohave County Sheriff's Department, the Mohave County Attorney's Office, the Washington County Attorney's Office, and the Washington County Sheriff's Office.



❖ For a copy of the Judgment obtained by the Arizona Attorney General's Office, which assessed civil penalties and issued a permanent injunction prohibiting discrimination, coercion, intimidation, and retaliation by the Cities and their associated utility providers.
