CHARGING VIOLATIONS OF:

**COUNT 1: FRAUDULENT SCHEMES
AND ARTIFICES**, a Class 2 Felony, in
violation of A.R.S. § 13-2310

COUNT 2: THEFT, a Class 2 Felony in
violation of A.R.S. § 13-1802

The 65th Arizona State Grand Jury accuses **REBECCA SUE SOTO**, charging on this
____ day of _____, 2009 that in or from Maricopa County, Arizona:

COUNT 1

FRAUDULENT SCHEMES AND ARTIFICES

On or between July 1, 2006 and July 31, 2008, defendant **REBECCA SUE SOTO**,
pursuant to a scheme or artifice to defraud, knowingly obtained a benefit by means of false or

fraudulent pretenses, representation, promises or material omissions, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-2310, 13-2310 (C), 13-2301, 13-701, 13-702, and 13-801.

Said conduct occurred when the defendant **REBECCA SUE SOTO** accepted cash and checks on behalf of the Tempe Union High School District (TUHSD) as the McClintock High School Bookstore Manager. She filed false Daily Check Out reports with the school district regarding funds she deposited into the school's bank account to which did not disclose the fact that she was actually depositing later-received funds to cover outstanding deposits. **SOTO** did this to cover up her diversion of some of the funds she received in her official capacity for her own personal use.

COUNT 2

THEFT

On or between July 1, 2006 and July 31, 2008, defendant **REBECCA SUE SOTO** knowingly converted for an unauthorized term or used services or property of another entrusted to the defendant or placed in the possession for a limited, authorized term or use in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-1802, 13-1802 (F), 13-1801, 13-701, 13-702, and 13-801.

Said conduct occurred when the defendant **REBECCA SUE SOTO** accepted cash and checks on behalf of the Tempe Union High School District (TUHSD) as the McClintock High School Bookstore Manager with the understanding that she was to deposit the money into TUHSD's bank accounts, but she used the money for personal use.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 21-425, the State Grand Jurors find that the offenses described above were committed in Maricopa County, Arizona.
