INDICTMENT

CHARGING VIOLATIONS OF:

Counts 1 & 2: Unauthorized Access to
Criminal History (ARS 41-1756, Class 6
Felonies)

The 66th Arizona State Grand Jury accuses TEISA SIMONE MAYFIELD VALLEJO,
charging on this 20th day of January, 2010, that in or from MARICOPA County, Arizona:

COUNT 1

UNAUTHORIZED ACCESS TO CRIMINAL HISTORY

On or about June 16, 2009, defendant TEISA SIMONE MAYFIELD VALLEJO
intentionally or knowingly used the Arizona criminal justice information system or criminal

history record information for a purpose other than as provided by A.R.S. § 41-1750, in violation of A.R.S. § 41-1756 (A)(2), 41-1750, 13-610, 13-701, 13-702 and 13-801.

Said conduct occurred when the defendant TEISA SIMONE MAYFIELD VALLEJO intentionally accessed the AHSC database, which contained criminal history record information, to search for information about her sister-in law without a lawful purpose.


COUNT 2

UNAUTHORIZED ACCESS TO CRIMINAL HISTORY

On or about June 16, 2009, defendant TEISA SIMONE MAYFIELD VALLEJO intentionally or knowingly used the Arizona criminal justice information system or criminal history record information for a purpose other than as provided by A.R.S. § 41-1750, in violation of A.R.S. § 41-1756 (A)(2), 41-1750, 13-610, 13-701, 13-702 and 13-801.


Said conduct occurred when the defendant TEISA SIMONE MAYFIELD VALLEJO intentionally accessed the AHQH database, which contained criminal history record information, to search for information about her sister-in law without a lawful purpose.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 21-425, the State Grand Jurors find that the offenses described above were committed in MARICOPA County, Arizona.


