Thank you for allowing Pima County until February 18 to respond to your February 9 letter. On February 16, the Pima County Board of Supervisors reconsidered its prior adoption of an eviction moratorium, which was adopted February 2, and voted to rescind it. Accordingly, although Pima County believes the moratorium adopted February 2 does not violate state law, the February 9 request for an investigation under A.R.S. § 41-194.01 is now moot.
