PROGRAMS



CONSUMER SCAMS

Don't get taken by a con artist or get stuck in another bad deal from a questionable contractor. Presenters will cover the most common scams in Arizona, tactics fraudsters use to steal your hard-earned money, and red flags. Attendees will be equipped with valuable prevention techniques and information about how to report consumer fraud.



LIFE CARE PLANNING

Learn about the importance of advance directives and the legal forms that everyone should have completed in the event they become unable to communicate their healthcare and/or mental healthcare wishes. Attendees will receive a Life Care Planning packet, which includes the Medical and Mental Health Care Powers of Attorney, Living Will, and Do Not Resuscitate forms.



ELDER ABUSE AWARENESS

Presenters will cover the different types of elder abuse, warning signs, and reporting procedures. They will also discuss the Arizona Attorney General's Task Force Against Senior Abuse (TASA), and provide statewide elder abuse resources.



HUMAN TRAFFICKING

Human Trafficking doesn't just happen in other countries; it happens right here in Arizona communities. Learn how traffickers in Arizona recruit their victims, the role of social media, and steps parents and others can take to protect children. We also provide real-life examples of human trafficking in Arizona and explain what you should do if you suspect someone may be a victim.



E-CIGARETTE AWARENESS

Presenters will bust the common myths and misconceptions about the e-cigarette and vaping industry. Attendees will learn about the evolution of e-cigarette products and the dangers associated with both the devices and vaping liquid or "e-juice".



OPIOID AWARENESS

This presentation focuses on the opioid epidemic plaguing Arizona. We will discuss numerous topics relating to how opioids can negatively affect people of all ages. Placing heavy focus on prevalence, prevention, and support.
