**COUNT 1: AGGRAVATED LURING A
MINOR FOR SEXUAL
EXPLOITATION, a Class 2 Felony, in
violation of A.R.S. § 13-3560**

**COUNT 2: PREPATORY SEXUAL
CONDUCT WITH A MINOR, a Class 3
Felony, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-1001,
13-1405**

**COUNTS 3-5: FURNISHING ITEMS TO
MINORS, a Class 4 Felony, in violation of
A.R.S. § 13-3506.01**

The Arizona State Grand Jury accuses **DAVID JAMES SEEFELD (001)**, charging on this 6th day of August 2019, that in or from Pima County, Arizona:

COUNT ONE
AGGRAVATED LURING A MINOR FOR SEXUAL EXPLOITATION,
A CLASS 2 FELONY

On or about July 25, 2019, through July 30, 2019, **DAVID JAMES SEEFELD (001)**, knowing the character and content of the depiction, used an electronic communication device to transmit at least one visual depiction of material that was harmful to minors for the purpose of initiating or engaging in communication with a recipient who **DAVID JAMES SEEFELD (001)** knew or had reason to know was a minor and, by means of the communication, **DAVID JAMES SEEFELD (001)** offered or solicited sexual conduct, knowing or having reason to know the person was a minor, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-3560, 13-301, 13-302, 13-303, 13-304, 13-601, 13-701, 13-705, 13-801, and 13-811.

COUNT TWO
PREPATORY SEXUAL CONDUCT WITH A MINOR, A CLASS 3 FELONY

On or about July 25, 2019, through July 30, 2019, **DAVID JAMES SEEFELD (001)** attempted to knowingly or intentionally engage in sexual intercourse or oral sexual conduct with a child under fifteen years of age, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-1001, 13-1405, 13-301, 13-302, 13-303, 13-304, 13-601, 13-701, 13-705, 13-801, and 13-811.

COUNT THREE
FURNISHING HARMFUL ITEMS TO MINORS, A CLASS 4 FELONY

On or about July 25, 2019, through July 30, 2019, **DAVID JAMES SEEFELD (001)**, intentionally or knowingly transmitted or sent to a minor by means of electronic mail, personal messaging or any other direct internet communication an item that is harmful to minors when, **DAVID JAMES SEEFELD (001)**, believed at the time of the transmission that a minor in this state would receive the item, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-3506.01, 13-301, 13-302, 13-303, 13-304, 13-601, 13-701, 13-705, 13-801, and 13-811.

COUNT FOUR
FURNISHING HARMFUL ITEMS TO MINORS, A CLASS 4 FELONY

On or about July 25, 2019, through July 30, 2019, **DAVID JAMES SEEFELD (001)**, intentionally or knowingly transmitted or sent to a minor by means of electronic mail, personal messaging or any other direct internet communication an item that is harmful to minors when, **DAVID JAMES SEEFELD (001)**, believed at the time of the transmission that a minor in this state would receive the item, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-3506.01, 13-301, 13-302, 13-303, 13-304, 13-601, 13-701, 13-705, 13-801, and 13-811.

COUNT FIVE
FURNISHING HARMFUL ITEMS TO MINORS, A CLASS 4 FELONY

On or about July 25, 2019, through July 30, 2019, **DAVID JAMES SEEFELD (001)**, intentionally or knowingly transmitted or sent to a minor by means of electronic mail, personal messaging or any other direct internet communication an item that is harmful to minors when,

DAVID JAMES SEEFELD (001), believed at the time of the transmission that a minor in this state would receive the item, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 13-3506.01, 13-301, 13-302, 13-303, 13-304, 13-601, 13-701, 13-705, 13-801, and 13-811.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 21-425, the State Grand Jurors find that the offenses described above were committed in Pima County, Arizona.
