COUNT 1: SOLICITATION TO COMMIT CHILD SEX TRAFFICKING, a Class 4 Felony, in violation of A R S §13-3212

COUNT 2: ATTEMPTED SEXUAL CONDUCT WITH A MINOR, a Class 3 Felony, in violation of A R S § 13-1405

COUNT 3: POSSESSION OF A DANGEROUS DRUG FOR SALE, a Class 2 Felony, in violation of A R S 13-3407

#### COUNT 1

#### SOLICITATION TO COMMIT CHILD SEX TRAFFICKING

On or about February 28, 2019, **THEODORE RICHARD WINDISH**, with the intent to promote or facilitate the commission of a felony, solicited a person to knowingly permit a minor under the age of 15, who is under the person's custody or control to engage in prostitution, in violation of A R S 13-3212, 13-1004, 13-701, 13-702, and 13-801

#### COUNT 2

#### ATTEMPTED SEXUAL CONDUCT WITH A MINOR

On or about February 28, 2019, **THEODORE RICHARD WINDISH** a person who is at least eighteen years of age, knowingly attempted to engage in sexual intercourse or oral sexual conduct with a person he knew or had reason to know was a minor under age 15, in violation of A R S §13-1001, 13-1401, 13-1405, 13-701, 13-702, 13-705, and 13-801

#### COUNT 3

## POSSESSION OF A DANGEROUS DRUG FOR SALE

On or about February 28, 2019, **THEODORE RICHARD WINDISH** knowingly possessed a dangerous drug for sale, to wit methamphetamine, in violation of A R S §13-3401, 13-3407, 13-701, 13-702, 13-705, and 13-801

### **COUNT 4**

## POSSESSION OF A NARCOTIC DRUG FOR SALE

On or about February 28, 2019, **THEODORE RICHARD WINDISH** knowingly possessed a narcotic drug for sale, to wit, cocaine, in violation of A R S §13-3401, 13-3408 13-701, 13-702, and 13-801
