INDICTMENT

CHARGING VIOLATIONS OF:

COUNT 1: FALSE REGISTRATION, a Class 6 Felony, in violation of A.R.S. § 16-182(A);

COUNT 2: ILLEGAL VOTING, a Class 5 Felony, in violation of A.R.S. §16-1016(1).

The 88th Arizona State Grand Jury accuses **MICHAEL DAMIAN HERRERA**, charging on this 2nd day of August, 2021, that in or from Pima County, Arizona:

COUNT 1

FALSE REGISTRATION

On or about September 6, 2020, **MICHAEL DAMIAN HERRERA**, knowingly caused, procured or allowed himself to be registered as an elector of any county, city, town, district or precinct, knowing that he is not entitled to such registration, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 16-182, 16-101, 13-701, 13-702 and 13-801.

Said conduct occurred when **MICHAEL DAMIAN HERRERA**, knowingly completed a voter registration form which stated in pertinent part "I am NOT a convicted FELON or my civil rights are restored" when in fact he had been convicted of Attempted Aggravated Assault on an Officer, a Class Six Felony, in Pima County Superior Court case CR 2015-2258 on or about October 16, 2015; Possession of Dangerous Drugs, a Class Four Felony, in Pima County Superior Court case CR 2018-0545 on July 27, 2018, and Securing the Proceeds of a Felony, a Class Six Felony, in Pima County Superior Court case CR 2018-0575 on July 27, 2018, and that he had not had his right to vote restored after July 27, 2018.

COUNT 2

ILLEGAL VOTING

During a period beginning on or about October 22, 2020, and ending on or about November 3, 2020, **MICHAEL DAMIAN HERRERA**, not being entitled to vote, knowingly voted, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 16-1016(1), 16-101, 16-1021, 13-701, 13-702 and 13-801.

Said conduct occurred when **MICHAEL DAMIAN HERRERA** voted in the November 2020 General Election despite having had his right to vote suspended because


of convictions for Attempted Aggravated Assault on an Officer, a Class Six Felony, in Pima County Superior Court case CR 2015-2258 on or about October 16, 2015; Possession of Dangerous Drugs, a Class Four Felony, in Pima County Superior Court case CR 2018-0545 on July 27, 2018, and Securing the Proceeds of a Felony, a Class Six Felony, in Pima County Superior Court case CR 2018-0575 on July 27, 2018, with his right to vote not having been restored after July 27, 2018.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 21-425, the Grand Jurors find that the offenses described above were committed in Pima County, Arizona.
