**INDICTMENT**

CHARGING VIOLATIONS OF:

**COUNT 1: FALSE REGISTRATION**, a Class 6 Felony, in violation of A.R.S. § 16-182(A);

**COUNT 2: ILLEGAL VOTING**, a Class 5 Felony, in violation of A.R.S. §16-1016(1).

The 88<sup>th</sup> Arizona State Grand Jury accuses **SHADAE ALEXIS SMITH a/k/a SHADAY ALEXIS SMITH and ALEXIS SHADAE SMITH**, charging on this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of August, 2021, that in or from Pima County, Arizona:

**COUNT 1**

**FALSE REGISTRATION**

On or about September 21, 2019, **SHADAE ALEXIS SMITH a/k/a SHADAY ALEXIS SMITH and ALEXIS SHADAE SMITH**, knowingly caused, procured or allowed herself to be registered as an elector of any county, city, town, district or precinct, knowing that she is not entitled to such registration, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 16-182, 16-101, 13-701, 13-702 and 13-801.

Said conduct occurred when **SHADAE ALEXIS SMITH a/k/a SHADAY ALEXIS SMITH and ALEXIS SHADAE SMITH**, knowingly completed a voter registration form which stated in pertinent part “I am NOT a convicted FELON or my civil rights are restored” when in fact she had been convicted of Theft, a Class Six Felony, in Santa Cruz County Superior Court case CR 09-283 on or about November 1, 2010, and Theft, a Class Six Felony, in Santa Cruz County Superior Court case CR 09-286 on or about November 1, 2010, and that she had not had her right to vote restored after that date.

**COUNT 2**

**ILLEGAL VOTING**

During a period beginning on or about October 22, 2020, and ending on or about November 3, 2020, **SHADAE ALEXIS SMITH a/k/a SHADAY ALEXIS SMITH and ALEXIS SHADAE SMITH**, not being entitled to vote, knowingly voted, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 16-1016(1), 16-101, 16-1021, 13-701, 13-702 and 13-801.


Said conduct occurred when **SHADAE ALEXIS SMITH a/k/a SHADAY ALEXIS SMITH and ALEXIS SHADAE SMITH** voted in the November 2020

General Election despite having had her right to vote suspended because of convictions for Theft, a Class Six Felony, in Santa Cruz County Superior Court case CR 09-283 on or about November 1, 2010, and Theft, a Class Six Felony, in Santa Cruz County Superior Court case CR 09-286 on or about November 1, 2010, with her right to vote not having been restored after that date.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 21-425, the Grand Jurors find that the offenses described above were committed in Pima County, Arizona.
