CHARGING VIOLATIONS OF:

COUNT 1: FALSE REGISTRATION, a Class 6 Felony, in violation of A.R.S. § 16-182(A);

COUNT 2: ILLEGAL VOTING, a Class 5 Felony, in violation of A.R.S. §16-1016(1).

The 88th Arizona State Grand Jury accuses **VICTOR MANUEL AGUIRRE**, charging on this 2nd day of August, 2021, that in or from Pima County, Arizona:

COUNT 1

FALSE REGISTRATION

On or about September 30, 2020, VICTOR MANUEL AGUIRRE, knowingly caused, procured or allowed himself to be registered as an elector of any county, city, town, district or precinct, knowing that he is not entitled to such registration, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 16-182, 16-101, 13-701, 13-702 and 13-801.

Said conduct occurred when VICTOR MANUEL AGUIRRE, knowingly completed a voter registration form which stated in pertinent part "I have NOT been convicted of a FELONY or my civil rights have been restored" when in fact he had been convicted of Criminal Trespassing, a Class Six Felony, in Maricopa County Superior Court case CR 2006-154527 on or about September 4, 2007; Unlawful Flight, a Class Five Felony, in Maricopa County Superior Court case CR 2008-137280 on August 26, 2008; Unlawful Use of Means of Transportation, a Class Five Felony, in Maricopa County Superior Court case CR 2010-127998 on July 20, 2010; Taking the Identity of Another, a Class Four Felony, in Maricopa County Superior Court case CR 2012-130189 on October 17, 2013; and Misconduct Involving Weapons, a Class Four Felony, in Pima County Superior Court case CR 2017-4565 on March 28, 2018, with his right to vote not having been restored after March 28, 2018.

COUNT 2

ILLEGAL VOTING

During a period beginning on or about October 22, 2020, and ending on or about November 3, 2020, VICTOR MANUEL AGUIRRE, not being entitled to vote,

knowingly voted, in violation of A.R.S. §§ 16-1016(1), 16-101, 16-1021, 13-701, 13-702 and 13-801.

Said conduct occurred when VICTOR MANUEL AGUIRRE voted in the November 2020 General Election despite having had his right to vote suspended because of convictions for Criminal Trespassing, a Class Six Felony, in Maricopa County Superior Court case CR 2006-154527 on or about September 4, 2007; Unlawful Flight, a Class Five Felony, in Maricopa County Superior Court case CR 2008-137280 on August 26, 2008; Unlawful Use of Means of Transportation, a Class Five Felony, in Maricopa County Superior Court case CR 2010-127998 on July 20, 2010; Taking the Identity of Another, a Class Four Felony, in Maricopa County Superior Court case CR 2012-130189 on October 17, 2013; and Misconduct Involving Weapons, a Class Four Felony, in Pima County Superior Court case CR 2017-4565 on March 28, 2018, with his right to vote not having been restored after March 28, 2018.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 21-425, the Grand Jurors find that the offenses described above were committed in Pima County, Arizona.
