

RESOLUTION 2006-030

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SIERRA VISTA, COCHISE COUNTY, ARIZONA; SUPPORTING ARIZONA HOUSE BILL 2815; AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER, CITY CLERK, CITY ATTORNEY, OR THEIR DULY AUTHORIZED OFFICERS AND AGENTS, TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSES AND INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the City of Sierra Vista supports legislation to fight clandestine meth labs; and

WHEREAS, meth is one of the leading law enforcement problems in the country; and

WHEREAS, production of meth exposes children, firefighters, law enforcement, and neighbors to toxic gases and hazardous chemicals ; and

WHEREAS, Representative Tom O'Halleran recently introduced legislation at the request of the Arizona State Attorney General in an effort to fight meth manufacturers and their illegal labs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SIERRA VISTA, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1

The policy of the City of Sierra Vista relating to the support of fighting the meth problem hereby is, affirmed.

Section 2

The Mayor and City Council hereby supports HB2815 to help fight meth abuse in Arizona.

Section 3

That the City Manager, City Clerk, City Attorney, or their duly authorized officers and agents are hereby authorized and directed to take all steps necessary to carry out the purposes and intent of this resolution.
